A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING  
BEACHES WITH LIFEGUARDS IN ATTENDANCE FOR  
THE 2025 SUMMER SEASON

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Sea Isle City, New Jersey, that the schedule of beaches, with members of the beach patrol in attendance, is, hereby, established for the 2025 summer season as follows:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that during the 2025 summer season, dependent upon need and availability of lifeguards, selected beaches may open earlier or later than scheduled.

**Guards will be in attendance from 10:00 AM to 5:00 PM Monday thru Friday and from 10:00 AM to 5:30 PM on Saturday and Sunday, unless otherwise indicated. Beach badges are required.**

**Saturday, August 2, 2025, all beaches with lifeguards on duty will close at 5:15 PM in order that the City may host the Captain Bill Gallagher Island Run.**

There will be two (2) volleyball nets permitted at each designated volleyball beach.
